This is the last Will and Testament of me
Thomas Swindlehurst

of Preston in the County of Lancaster Roller Maker I devise all my real estate and bequeath all my personal estate unto my sons Charles Edward Swindlehurst Thomas Newton Swindlehurst and my friend Thomas Keeler of Preston aforesaid his plate worker hereinafter called my trustees their heirs executors administrators and assigns As to the real and personal estate not belonging to me beneficially upon trust to dispose thereof according to the trusts and equities affecting the same And as to the real and personal estate belonging to me beneficially upon trust to dispose thereof according to the directions hereinafter contained And I authorize and empower my trustees at such time or times as having regard to the trusts and purposes of this my Will and the state and interest of my beneficiaries they shall judge expedient to convert into money and get in my personal estate and also to sell all or any part or parts of my real estate by public auction or private sale together or in lots with power to make any special or other conditions of sale as to the title or evidence of title or otherwise and to buy in the premises or any part or parts thereof at any sale by public auction and to receive either on terms or gratuitously any contract or contracts and to settle without being answerable for any loss and to give by their receipts in writing good and valid discharges for purchase money and in the meantime to let from year to year or for any term or terms of years or to occupy and use my said real estate or any part or parts thereof and to manage the affairs of my said real estate and personal estate hereinafter comprised under the denomination of "my trust property" generally at their discretion but subject to the directions hereinafter contained And I hereby direct that my trustees shall permit my dear wife Margaret to have the rents and income of my real estate and of such parts of my personal estate as shall be or be capable of producing income and of the proceeds of the sale and conversion into money of my real and personal estate and the use and enjoyment of those portions of my personal estate which shall not from their nature be capable of producing income for and during her natural life And shall also during the like period permit my said wife to carry on for her own benefit the business in which I shall be engaged at the time of my decease she having therein the assistance of my son Charles Edward on such terms as to his remuneration and otherwise as to my trustees shall seem just and to employ in such business all or any part of my real and personal estate or the proceeds thereof And I empower my trustees

whenever they in their uncontrolled discretion shall from time to time think fit to allow all such sum and sums of money out of the corpus of my estate as they shall think necessary in order to augment the income receivable by her to such a sum as shall suffice to provide her with every necessary and comfort and medicine and medical advice and nursing in time of sickness I declare that my trustees shall not be obliged to take any part in the management of the said business or be responsible for any loss which may happen therein or for any diminution of the capital employed therein and subject as heretofore appears I direct my trustees to stand possessed of my said trust property and the proceeds thereof in trust for such of my children as shall be living at the time of my decease and the issue then living of such of my children as shall then be dead in equal shares as tenants in common but so that the issue of every deceased child shall take through all the degrees the share which the parent of such issue if living would have taken and I declare that the share to which every female shall be or become entitled under this my Will whether as being herein expressly named or indicated or by reason of any event happening after the execution hereof shall be for her sole and separate use independently of the debts control interference or engagements of her husband and that her receipt for the same shall notwithstanding cover and be a good discharge to my trustees and that (subject to the trusts and directions herein contained) my trustees may if they in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion shall think fit so to do apply the whole or such part as they shall from time to time think fit of the income of the share to which any minor shall be or become presumptively entitled under this my Will whether as being herein expressly named or indicated or by reason of any event happening after the execution hereof for or towards the maintenance or education of such minor during his or her minority either directly or to his or her guardians or guardian (if any) and if none to the person ^{or persons} with whom for the time being such minor shall be residing without seeing to the application thereof or requiring any account for the same and that my trustees need not unless they think fit so to do require from my said wife an inventory of any effects the use whereof I have bequeathed to her and that they shall not be answerable for any loss or damage happening thereto or any diminution in the value thereof during the time she shall be entitled to enjoy the use thereof and that any monies belonging to or arising from my real or personal estate not immediately applicable may be invested by my trustees and that all investments to be made in carrying out the trusts and purposes of this my Will shall be made in or upon any of the public stocks or funds of Great

Britain or at interest upon Government or real or leasehold premises in England or Wales or upon Indian Stock or in or upon the premises of any Company incorporated by Act of Parliament or Royal Charter and paying a dividend or in or upon the bonds mortgages or debentures of the Municipal Corporation of the Borough of Preston or the Local Sanitary Authority of the same Borough or of any other Municipal Corporation or Local Sanitary Authority and that my trustees shall have power in their discretion to vary such investments for any other investment of the description herein specified And that my trustees may from time to time employ an Agent to collect rents or look after and manage my real estate and to pay to such Agent out of the income of my best property a reasonable remuneration And that the expression my trustees used in this my Will shall be construed and taken to mean the trustees or trustee for the time being of this my Will And I Appoint my said sons Charles Edward Swindlehurst and Thomas Newton Swindlehurst and the said Thomas Keeder executors of this my Will and I revoke all other Wills by me previously made I WITNESS whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand this thirtieth day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty one.
